NBI Interim Procedure for the disclosure of information about investment projects

undertaken through the Nile Basin Initiative investment programs

1. Preamble

The NILE-COM,

Considering that, under the umbrella of the Nile Basin Initiative (NBI), the NBI Member Countries have developed a Shared Vision Objective (the 'Shared Vision') to achieve sustainable socio-economic development through the equitable utilization of, and benefit from, the common Nile Basin water resources;

Recognizing that this Shared Vision can be preserved and nurtured primarily through joint cooperative efforts;

Desirous to maintain and enhance their cooperative relations and achieve mutual benefit from their Shared Vision through the realization of the NBI investment programs;

Recognizing that the systematic disclosure of information about investment projects under the NBI investment programs at specified stages during the project cycle will further strengthen cooperation and trust between the NBI Member Countries and their populations by promoting transparency and avoiding misconceptions;

Further noting that strengthened cooperation between NBI Member Countries on the basis of project information disclosure will facilitate the timely and successful realization of such projects;

Hereby agrees to this interim procedure (Interim Procedure) as follows:

2. Acronyms and definitions

DEFINITIONS

- **Investment project** means a project that involves the construction of physical infrastructure and which may have impacts on water resources;
- Project cycle means the process of identifying, preparing, evaluating, approving, mobilizing, implementing and operating an investment project;
- NBI Investment Project means an investment project, or a proposed investment project, for
 which NBI through its centers, ENTRO and/or NELSAP-CU, has been mandate by the NBI Member
 Countries to prepare and/or implement at the time when project disclosure takes place in
 accordance with this Procedure and which is either a multi-country project or a project that may
 have transboundary effects within the Nile Basin;
- Multi-country project means an investment project that is implemented on the territories of two
 or more NBI Member Countries;
- Project information disclosure means the formal disclosure of information relating to an NBI Investment Project in an agreed format at specified stages during the project cycle in accordance with this procedure;
- Project information means the information about an NBI Investment Project that is disclosed in accordance with this procedure;
- Project preparation involves the study of the technical, institutional, social, economic, environmental and financial aspects of a proposed investment project and other measures necessary for the assessment or appraisal of such a project and which result in the project preparation documents;
- Project preparation documents mean a detailed feasibility study, an ESIA report and a preliminary design;
- Project implementation includes the measures taken, after the necessary financing is secured, to
 construct an investment project including the preparation of specifications and tenders, the
 undertaking of physical construction works, as well as related measures to prevent or mitigate
 environmental and social impacts;
- NBI National Focal Point Institution means the Ministry responsible for water affairs in an NBI Member Country;
- Mandated regional centre means ENTRO in the case of an NBI Investment Project that involves ENTRO and NELSAP-CU in the case of an NBI Investment Project that involves NELSAP-CU.

3. Objective

The objective of this procedure is to ensure the formal disclosure of information about NBI Investment Projects at specific stages of the project cycle in order to promote cooperation and trust between NBI Member Countries thereby facilitating the timely and successful realisation of such projects.

4. Scope

- 4.1. This procedure applies to all NBI Investment Projects.
- 4.2. The primary recipients of project information disclosure are the NFPIs of NBI Member Countries but certain project information shall also be disclosed to the general public through publication on the website of the mandated regional centre.

5. Triggers for project information disclosure

- 5.1. Information that the preparation of a proposed NBI Investment Project has been approved in accordance with the internal procedure of the relevant regional mandated center shall be disclosed in the form attached as Form A for information purposes at the next meeting of the NILE-COM following that approval.
- 5.2. Detailed information about an NBI Investment Project, in the form attached as Form B, shall be disclosed following the finalization of the project preparation documents relating to that project.
- 5.3. Information that an NBI Member Country has formally approved an NBI Investment Project within its territory, in accordance with its own procedures, shall be disclosed using the form attached as Form C for information purposes at the next meeting of the NILE-COM following that approval
- 5.4. In the event that an NBI center is given the mandate to implement an NBI investment project, information that the implementation of an NBI Investment Project has begun, shall be disclosed in the form attached as Form D together with any update to the detailed information on the project using the form attached as Form B.

6. Project information disclosure procedure

- 6.1. In connection with project information disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 1 to 4 of article 5 of this interim procedure, the procedure shall be as follows:
- 6.1.1. the relevant mandated regional centre shall prepare draft project information in the specified format and shall transmit that draft information to the NFPI of the NBI Member Country in which the NBI Investment Project is located for comment and approval. In the case of a multi-country project, the draft project information shall be sent to the NFPI of each relevant NBI country;
- 6.1.2. on receipt of the draft project information the NFPI shall notify the mandated regional centre of its approval of the draft project information or shall request any amendments to the project documentation which the mandated regional centre shall make;
- 6.1.3. the mandated regional centre shall transmit the approved project information to the NILE-SEC;
- 6.1.4. the NILE-SEC shall verify the NFPI's approval and
- 6.1.5. In connection with project information disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 2 and 4 of article 5, the Executive Director of the NILE-SEC shall transmit the project information by electronic means to the NFPI of each other NBI Member Country and shall also forward a copy of such information to every member of the NILE TAC.
- 6.1.6. In connection with project information disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 3 of article 5, NILE-SEC shall include the project information as an agenda item at the next meeting of the NILE-COM.

7. Disclosure of project information to the general public

7.1. A summary of the characteristics of an NBI Investment Project shall be published on the website of the NILE-SEC in the format attached as Form E following the preparation of the final project preparation documents relating to that project.

7.2. Information that the implementation of NBI Investment Project has started shall be published on the website of the NILE-SEC in the format attached as Form F.

8. Implementation arrangements

8.1. Roles and responsibilities of the NFPIs

The roles and responsibilities of the NFPIs in implementing this Interim Procedure shall include:

- 8.1.1. reviewing and approving draft project information transmitted by a mandated regional centre relating to an NBI investment project that is wholly or partly in the NBI Member Country concerned;
- 8.1.2. receiving project disclosure information sent by the NILE-SEC regarding NBI Investment Projects in other NBI Member Countries.

8.2. Roles and responsibilities of the NILE TAC

The roles and responsibilities of the NILE TAC in implementing this Interim Procedure shall include:

- 8.2.1. supervise the implementation of this Interim Procedure;
- 8.2.2. review the status of implementation of this Interim Procedure and providing guidance for improvement.

8.3. Roles and responsibilities of the NILE-SEC

The roles and responsibilities of the NILE-SEC in implementing this Interim Procedure shall include:

- 8.3.1. forwarding project information received pursuant to this Interim Procedure to the NILE-COM and, as appropriate, to the NFPI of each other NBI Member Country and the members of the NILE TAC;
- 8.3.2. undertaking due diligence so as to ensure that project information is approved by the relevant NBI Member Country (ies) before the information is disclosed in accordance with this Interim Procedure;;
- 8.3.3. undertaking due diligence on draft project information for disclosure to the general public submitted by the mandated regional centres and publishing that information on the NILE-SEC website;
- 8.3.4. acting as the depositary (archiving and storing) of project information disclosed in accordance with this Interim Procedure;
- 8.3.5. any other such additional matters the NILE TAC shall consider appropriate.

8.4. Roles and responsibilities of the mandated regional centres

The roles and responsibilities of the mandated regional centres in implementing this Interim Procedure shall include:

- 8.4.1. preparing the project information specified in this Interim Procedure and submitting the relevant forms to the NFPIs of the NBI Member Countries concerned for approval;
- 8.4.2. transmitting approved project information to the NILE SEC;

8.4.3. preparing project information for disclosure to the public and transmitting this to the NILE-SEC for publication;

9. Final clauses

- 9.1. This Interim Procedure shall be effective immediately upon being confirmed by a minute of Nile-COM.
- 9.2. This Interim Procedure shall remain effective until further notice from the Nile-COM.
- 9.3. This Interim Procedure shall be reviewed by the NILE TAC on a periodic basis, as required.


